



Packing List

Every single item brought to camp should be clearly marked with your child's name. Campers should bring their clothing and personal effects in a trunk or small footlocker.

Each camper should bring:

- 2 laundry bags
- 6 towels
- 2 washcloths
- 1 pillow
- 2 pillowcases
- 2 sets of sheets for a single bunk
- 2 blankets, toiletries
- sleeping garments
- 10 pairs undergarments
- 10 pairs socks
- 2 bathing suits
- 8 pairs of shorts (at least one khaki)
- 8 T-shirts
- 1 sweatshirt or fleece
- 1 rain jacket
- 2 pairs jeans
- 1 pair tennis
- shoes
- 1 pair sports sandals or water shoe for river exploration
- 1 pair hiking boots or sturdy sneaker
- flashlight
- soap case or shower caddy
- sleeping bag (synthetic fill recommended)
- water bottle or canteen

Other optional items include:

- disposable camera
- fishing rod
- riding boots
- Bible
- tennis racquet
- tennis balls
- nicer outfit for dance
- costumes
- wigs
- extra pair of prescription glasses
- sunglasses
- camping equipment
- athletic equipment
- musical instrument
- stationary
- backpack
- fan

Parents please supervise your child's packing and make sure they do not bring the following items to camp: large stereos, electronic games, candy, gum, all knives, fireworks, weapons, matches, lighters, food, offensive music, beepers, cellular phones, computers, jewelry, or other valuables that have no place in a outdoor, summer camp environment.
